

Litter Bug Reporting

To help Bluegrass PRIDE ensure that a litter bug is reported, please make sure all of the information is complete and given in a timely matter.

- Full license plate number-For specialty plates, please include the small letters/numbers at the end of the plate.
- Type of litter-This is very important to educate people on littering. Many people do not realize that a cigarette butt is considered littering.
- Issuing State for the license plate
- Vehicle Description -The vehicle description is run with the license plate number to verify that the correct vehicle has been reported.
- County-This is the county in which the littering occurred. That county will be the one that issues the warning letter to the violator.
- Location-This information is helpful for mapping any areas with litter problems.
- Date/Time-Please include the date and time of the violation. Also, please turn in all litter reports in a timely matter. **Most counties have a 30-day cut off.** If a litter violation is turned in several months after it occurs, the violator may not receive a warning letter, depending on the county.
